Application Fee

Parents/Guardians may enroll a student by completing an Application for Enrolment Form and paying the Application Fee of \$75 (including GST). This fee covers administrative costs and is non-refundable. Payment of this fee does not guarantee admission. The fee is not tax deductible.

Admission Fee

Confirmation of the enrolment is dependent upon a successful interview with the Principal or a delegate and the payment of the Admission Fee, \$650 for the first child and \$275 for each subsequent child from the same family. Payment of the Admission Fee will secure your child's place in the School. The Admission Fee is non-refundable, is not offset against Tuition Fees and is not tax deductible.

Tuition fees do not include the cost of text books, personal stationery items, uniforms, school bags or building levy. Text books are purchased through Champion Education. Apple ICT devices are also required for Years 3 – 12, please check the School website, under Enrolments, Book Lists & Devices, for specifications.

Fee Discounts

A 4.0% discount for annual Tuition Fees paid in full before 20 February 2026.

Sibling discounts

20% discount for the annual tuition fees for the second child

40% discount for the third child

Fourth and subsequent children will only pay fees as below;

Kindergarten – Year 2: \$150.00

Years 3-6: \$200.00

Year 7-11: \$400.00

No sibling discount applies to Pre-Kindergarten children.

Additional Fees and Charges

Building Levy

All families are charged a building levy of \$620.00 per annum (\$162.50 per term).

Notice of Withdrawal

The School must be given at least one school terms notice in writing prior to the withdrawal of a student from the School e.g. if you wish to withdraw a student at the end of the term, notice must be received by the School on the 1st day back of that term. A term's fees will be charged in lieu of notice.

Optional School Camp – Year 8 - Canberra

An additional cost of \$2,600.00 will be charged for students attending this camp to Canberra.

Optional School Camp – Year 10 - Ningaloo

An additional cost of \$1,200.00 will be charged for students attending this camp to Ningaloo.

NB: Students will not be eligible to participate in optional excursions (eg. camps) if their school fee account is not in good standing order.

Late / Non-Payment

Parents who are unable to pay fees by the due date must contact the Business Manager to make alternative arrangements.

Financial Assistance

Temporary financial assistance, in the form of a discount against fees, is available where families experience short-term financial difficulties. If these circumstances arise you should make an appointment with the Business Manager. Such matters are treated in the strictest confidence.

Fee Payment Options

Option 1:

Pay the full tuition amount in one payment and receive a **4% discount** (tuition fees only) if paid by **20 February 2026**.

Option 2:

Make regular payments via **weekly, fortnightly, monthly, or quarterly direct debits**. These can be set up through the **Parent Lounge**. Further details about accessing the Parent Lounge will be provided with your statement.

Option 3:

Pay in **four term instalments**, due on the following dates:

- 20 February
- 8 May
- 7 August
- 30 October

Split Billing

The School does not accept split billing requests without the submission of a court issued custody order. Existing and new split billing does not remove joint and several liability for the payment of fees.

Music Lessons

The school facilitates the provision of private music lessons for enrolled students in a number of musical instruments. Please contact the school for availability and costs.

Buses

In addition to the buses operated by the Public Transport Authority, the School operates a limited number of private buses to take students to and from school. Please contact the School for more information regarding current routes and to register for the private service.

It is strongly recommended that parents check their health cover and insurance policies to ensure adequate medical, ambulance, personal property and liability insurance cover is held. The School does not accept responsibility for loss of, or damage to, personal effects and property, or for bodily injury or property damage incurred by students.

Students at the School are covered by Personal Accident insurance, which provides limited cover only, excluding all Medicare services including the Medicare gap.

Parents will be required to make good any damage to school property or equipment (other than fair wear and tear) caused by students.
